Internship Description: The Intern will assist the program through historical research, archaeological excavation, lab analysis, public outreach, and publication and presentation of findings. The Intern will gain experience working in a Cultural Resource Management setting, unique to their educational experience. Requirements: The applicant must be in good-standing at Michigan State University, and must have taken part in an Archaeological Field School. Students majoring in Anthropology are preferred, although others are more than welcome. The position will require between 5-10 hours per week.
